- 1. In The Disappeared, we meet three very different mothers: Esme, Lorena, and Vivian. Which one of these women do you relate most to, and why?
- 2. Esme believes that Claudio put Lorena's life at risk. What role do you think Claudio played in Lorena's life?
- 3. The Disappeared explores the relationships between biological parents, adoptive parents, and children. Do you think adoptive children should know about their biological identity?
- 4. Vivian feels that it's a selfish indulgence to pry into her husband's secrets. Why do you think she refrains from asking him important questions?
- 5. How did the author explore themes of motherhood in the novel? Do you think motherhood is a universal experience?
- **6.** Esme believes that faith is belief in the absence of proof. How do the different characters in *The Disappeared* exhibit Esme's definition of faith?
- 7. Do you think Rachel's behavior toward Jonathan at the end of the book was justified? How do you think Rachel will navigate her relationship with Jonathan in the future?
- 8. The book explores themes of identity and truth. How would you react if you learned that part of your own biological identity was not what you thought it was?
